## What is a Teacher & Learning Lead?

The Teacher & Learning Lead at the Experience Church's Learning Hub, in partnership with Airdrie Christian Academy, is a vital role designed to integrate expert teaching with leadership within a faith-based educational framework. This role combines traditional classroom responsibilities with strategic oversight to enhance the learning environment and operational effectiveness of the Hub.

**Teaching and Curriculum Delivery:** As a Teacher & Learning Lead, you will deliver a curriculum that aligns with Alberta Education standards, infused with a biblically-based perspective. You will plan, implement, and assess engaging lessons tailored to meet diverse student needs while fostering an environment that encourages both academic excellence and spiritual growth. Teachers in this role are expected to embody and promote the biblical values that form the foundation of our educational philosophy.

**Educational Leadership:** Beyond instructing, this role extends into coordinating with the Hub Director and ACA to optimize educational practices and resource management. You will mentor and support fellow educators, enhancing professional development and ensuring the efficacy of teaching methods across the Hub. Your efforts will support a cohesive educational experience that aligns with our Christian values and educational goals.

**Community and Collaboration:** In collaboration with the Learning Hub Coordinator and educational team, you will work to ensure a supportive, structured, and spiritually enriching learning environment. This role is pivotal in linking educational objectives with day-to-day teaching activities and in fostering a community where biblical principles guide learning and interaction.

Ideal candidates are passionate about education, exhibit strong leadership capabilities, and are committed to advancing both the intellectual and spiritual development of students. This role is for educators who align deeply with our statement of beliefs, embrace our values, and are enthusiastic about contributing to a visionary educational setting at the EC Learning Hub.

## Responsibilities (What you'll do)

#### Educational Delivery and Oversight (4 days/week):

- Deliver engaging, curriculum-aligned instruction to students in shared-grade classrooms.
- Assess and report on student achievement and progress.
- Utilize a variety of instructional strategies to meet diverse learner needs.

#### Learning Lead (1 day/week):

- Coordinate with the Hub Director on administrative duties including educational programming, teacher supervision, budgetary planning, and student support services.
- Assist in classroom placements and teacher duty assignments, optimizing the use of teacher skills and experience.
- Develop and support a positive staff culture in collaboration with the Hub Director, ACA Principal, and the EC Executive Team.
- Create teaching and supervision schedules that enhance educational delivery and staff development.
- Plan, develop, and help implement high-quality lessons and courses across various grades.
- Provide resources, support, and advocacy for teachers, enhancing their ability to deliver exceptional educational experiences.

## Qualifications (What you know)

- Education Degree, with preference given to candidates with elementary grades training and at least 5 years of teaching experience. Leadership Quality Standard Certification (LQS) would be considered an asset.
- Valid Alberta Teachers Certificate (interim or permanent).
- Exceptional leadership, communication (verbal and written), and interpersonal skills.
- Demonstrated ability to organize effectively, meet deadlines, and handle multiple concurrent tasks.
