## Temporary Part Time Middle Years Science Position - Red Deer

### Synopsis

ACA@Home is offering a 1 Day/Week Shared Responsibility program for grade 1-9 Home Education families. On that day, students will take Science, PE, Drama and Art. **ACA@Home is looking for a temporary 0.3 FTE teacher to teach that one day/week. The position will include a Grade 5/6 Science and a Grade 7/8 Science.** The candidate must be available in person each Wednesday, and online throughout the rest of the week. There is also an opportunity to combine this 0.3 teaching role with some Home Education Facilitator FTE to fill out a more well-rounded role. These flexible options will be discussed in interviews with qualified candidates.

### Qualifications

The ACA@Home Teacher must be a born again Christian who is in full agreement with our Statement of Faith, agrees to abide by the school's Moral Conduct Policy, and is committed to fulfilling the School's Mission.

*The ACA@Home Teacher must:*

- Have a Bachelor of Education degree
- Hold a valid Alberta Education Teaching Certificate
- Be creative, independent and a self-starter
- Be supportive of home education

- Conduct themselves in a professional manner

*The following will be considered assets:*

- Experience in teaching middle years grades
- Education/Experience in teaching Science
- Experience with Google Suite and online learning tools

### **Responsibilities**

1. Cooperate with the ACA@Home Principal, senior leadership and administration in implementing all policies, procedures and directives governing the school.
2. Possess knowledge of the Alberta Education Program of Studies.
3. Possess knowledge of best practices and strategies in creating engaging lessons, assignments and projects for students.
4. Demonstrate operational ability of Online systems and technologies.
5. Assess academic progress of students and provide written reports.
6. Communicate with parents and administration regarding concerns of academic development.
7. Represent ACA@Home in a favourable and professional manner to families and the general public.
8. Develop and maintain rapport with students, parents and colleagues by treating others with respect, dignity, and kindness.
9. Maintain a growth mindset and seek counsel from parents, staff and administration.
10. Attend and participate in meetings and events (Community Days, Field Trips) related to the role in ACA@Home.
11. Continuously seek opportunities to grow spiritually and professionally.
12. Perform other duties as assigned by the administration.

### **Spiritual Responsibilities**

1. To model in speech, actions, and attitude, a consistent daily walk with Jesus Christ.
2. To show by example the importance of the Word of God, prayer, fellowship, and Christian service.

### **Time Commitment**

This is a 0.3 FTE position as the teaching time is 1 day per week plus another ½ day online. As in a 1.0 teaching job, time to prepare, assess, and plan may fall outside of this one day per week. It is expected that teachers do complete work outside of the teaching day. Time requirements include:

Being available for phone calls and emails from a family (ongoing).

Attend monthly staff meetings and two full day staff meetings per year.

Complete an annual Teacher Growth Plan.

### **Accountability**

1. The ACA@Home Teacher will report directly to the ACA@Home Vice Principal.
2. The ACA@Home Teacher will be annually reviewed by the ACA@Home Principal
