This role involves planning and creatively delivering Alberta curriculum-aligned lessons that cater to diverse learning styles while building a supportive and collaborative classroom community.

Duties:

- Design age-appropriate lessons that align with curriculum goals and foster learning in areas such as literacy, numeracy, and social skills
- Teach foundational skills like reading, writing, counting, and basic science through engaging and interactive methods
- Maintain a safe and positive learning environment, encouraging good behavior and resolving conflicts as they arise
- Foster emotional and social development, teaching children to express their feelings, work in teams, and respect others
- Monitor and evaluate students' progress through observation, assignments, and informal assessments, providing feedback to support growth

- Ensure the well-being of students by promoting good hygiene, managing illnesses or injuries, and supervising during activities and transitions.
- Regularly communicate with parents/guardians about their child's development and address any concerns
